A perfect home-like toilet solution built-in a recreational vehicle

Bench model

The built-in Cassette Toilet is a permanently installed toilet with 2 essentials parts:

1 A flushing system



Inside the recreational vehicle you experience home-like comfort.

2 A waste-holding tank



Outside the recreational vehicle you find access to the removable Cassette or so called waste-holding tank.

FAQ's

Q: Can I use my normal household cleaners?

A: No. Normal household cleaners may cause permanent damage to seals and other toilet components. Therefore Thetford has a wide range of specially developed toilet care products.

Q: I can't remove the waste-holding tank?

A: Check if the blade is (partly) open. If the blade is stuck, first loosen the cap from the pour out spout.

Q: What do I need to know about my toilet while driving?

A: To prevent leakage or water damage to your caravan or motor home, do not travel with water in the toilet bowl, a flush-water tank that is more than 1/2 full nor with a waste-holding tank that is more than 3/4 full.

1 Flushing System

Always a quiet yet powerful and fresh flush

Flushing system: preparing to use

A Integrated flush-water tank



Fill with water and add the correct dosage of Aqua Rinse Plus.


Swivel bowl model:
Fill via water filler door (outside vehicle).



Bench model:
Fill via waterfill funnel (outside vehicle behind service door).



B Flush-water supplied from vehicle's central water tank



Fill central water tank via external water connection. Use Aqua Rinse Spray in the toilet bowl before you flush the toilet.



The perfect flush



- 1 Use Aqua Rinse Plus (A) or Aqua Rinse Spray (B) for a fresh odour and perfect flush.
- 2 Open the blade with the blade handle
- 3 - Flush your toilet off road without any power (for manual models)
- Use electrical flush for easy flush
- 4 A perfect flush

2 Waste-holding tank

The clever replacement for a sewage system

Pour out spout

Gives an easy and clean way to empty the tank

Vent button

Prevents splashing when emptying the tank

Blade

Closes the tank to keep the bathroom smelling fresh



Wheels and handle

Makes it easy to get the tank to the dump station

Waste-holding tank: preparing to use



- 1 Open the service door on the outside of your vehicle and remove the waste-holding tank.
- 2 Add the correct dosage of water and Aqua Kem Blue (Sachets) or Aqua Kem Green (Sachets) for perfect odour control and easier emptying.

Emptying the waste-holding tank



- 3 Look at the level indicator if the tank needs to be emptied.
- 4 Just move the waste-holding tank by the wheels and handle to the special dump station on the campsite.
- 5 Turn the pour out spout and remove the cap.
- 6 Press and hold the vent button with your thumb while the pour out spout is pointing downwards. Empty the waste-holding tank
