To Prepare Toilet for New Pedals

- Remove Toilet from Closet Flange (see Owner's Manual).
- 2. Turn Toilet upside down.
- 3. Remove wire/ball keepers from bottom of pedal (1 screw in each).
- 4. Remove Mechanism Cover (4 screws).
- 5. Turn toilet upright.
- Release torsion spring, using needle nose pliers, by firmly holding onto long arm of spring and pulling back until spring can be released from keeper on water lever.
- 7. Open blade and valve manually by pushing down on pedals.
- 8. Turn Toilet upside down. Balls should now be free of pedals.
- Take hold of water (small) pedal only and slowly lift up, simultaneously pulling wire with ball forward to clear socket. Flush (large) pedal now starts to lift.
- 10. Pull wire and ball forward to clear socket. Lift pedals up out of the way.
- 11. Remove pivot bearings (2 screws on each) where pedals are attached at base.

To Install New Pedals

- 1. Secure down one pivot bearing (angled edges to outside of toilet) with 2 screws.
- 2. Hold pedals so top of pedal faces top of toilet.
- Slide other pivot bearing (angled edges to toilet outside) onto pedals. Ease pedals into fixed bearing, lowering other bearing onto screw bosses.
- 4. Secure using 2 screws. Check pedals for easy movement.
- To attach balls to Pedal Socket: Hold small pedal, which lowers large (flush) pedal. Pull forward on wire so ball can access hole socket. Attach ball retainers to pedals (1 screw each).
- 6. Turn Toilet upright.
- 7. Insure ball valve actuator linkage is located in small hole in water lever.
- 8. Reattach torsion spring by hand, or use needle nose pliers. Ease long arm of spring into spring retainer on water lever.
- Check for 100% open/close of ball valve and blade.
- 10. Reattach Mechanism Cover. Turn Toilet over. Secure with 4 screws.
- 11. Remount toilet to Closet Flange. See Owner's Manual.
