
Instructions for Thetford Part #33011 ("Bent Screwdriver")


Use the tool to clean groove:

- 1. Depress the two foot pedals to slide the blade back and fully expose the seal groove for cleaning.
- 2. Insert the tool at the "4 o'clock" position.
- 3. Rotate the tool clockwise to scrape out the debris. (You may experience resistance which may require added twisting force to remove the buildup.)
- 4. The tool should leave seal at about the "6 o'clock" position.



Note: Since cleaning of the seal groove is more pleasant after draining, rinsing and deodorizing the holding tank, we recommend that this be a routine procedure, rather than an on-the-road fix.

Note: Take care to avoid letting Screwdriver drop down toilet






